

Easy loading for any and all Indicators for computer challenged folks like myself:

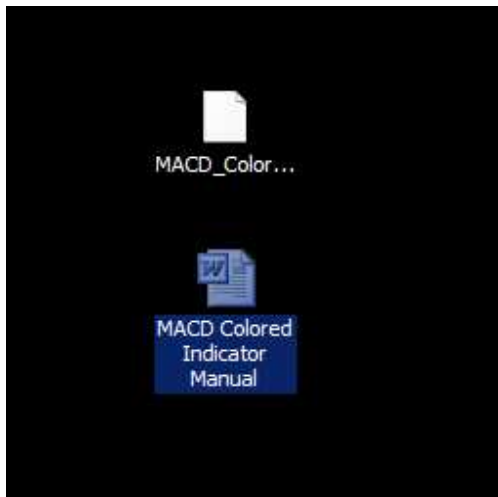
For MT4 v 1.0.0.1

Close your MT4 platform before starting:

These steps outlined below are for use with Vista OS. If you are using a different OS the individual steps may vary slightly, but you should be able to get to your Indicator folder following this order.

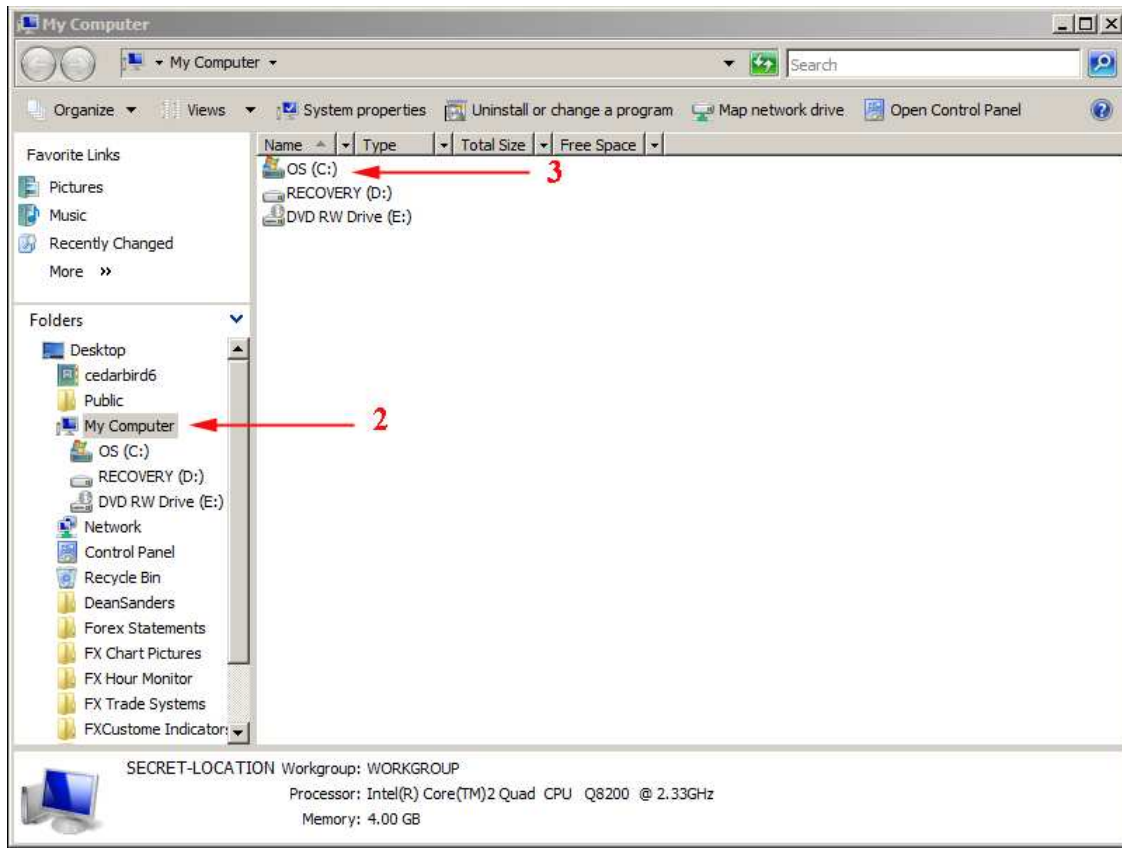
The file must have a **.mq4** extension for these steps to function smoothly. Other file extensions will work but this one works without additional prep.

1: Down load files from page 1 post #13 to your desk top: (MACD Colored_v103 and the Word document)

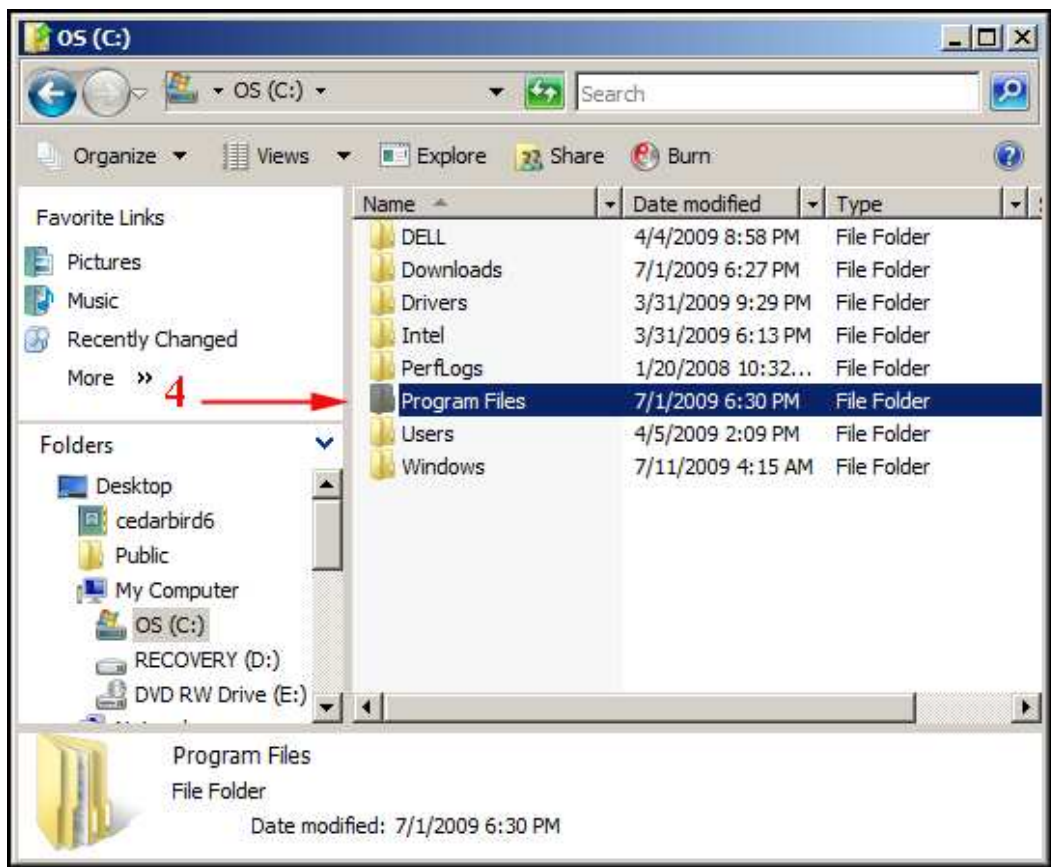


2: Double click on My Computer:

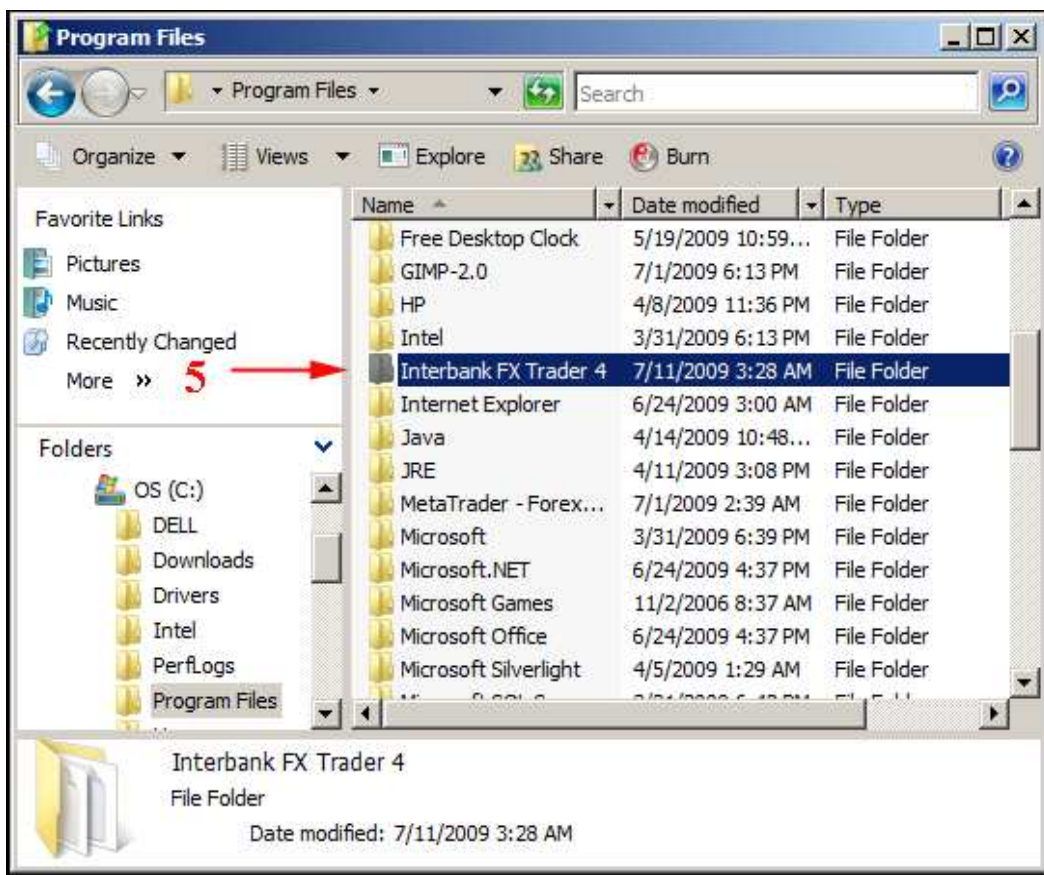
3: Double click on your C drive:



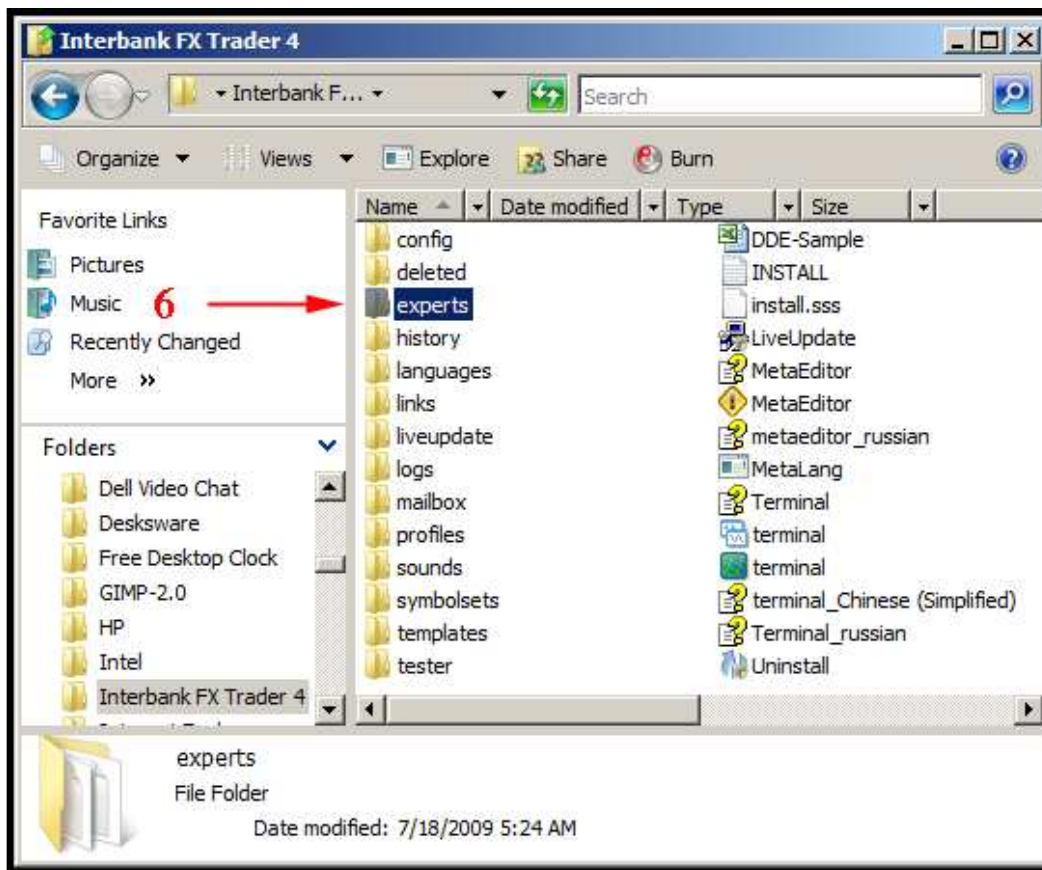
4: Double click on your Program File Folder:



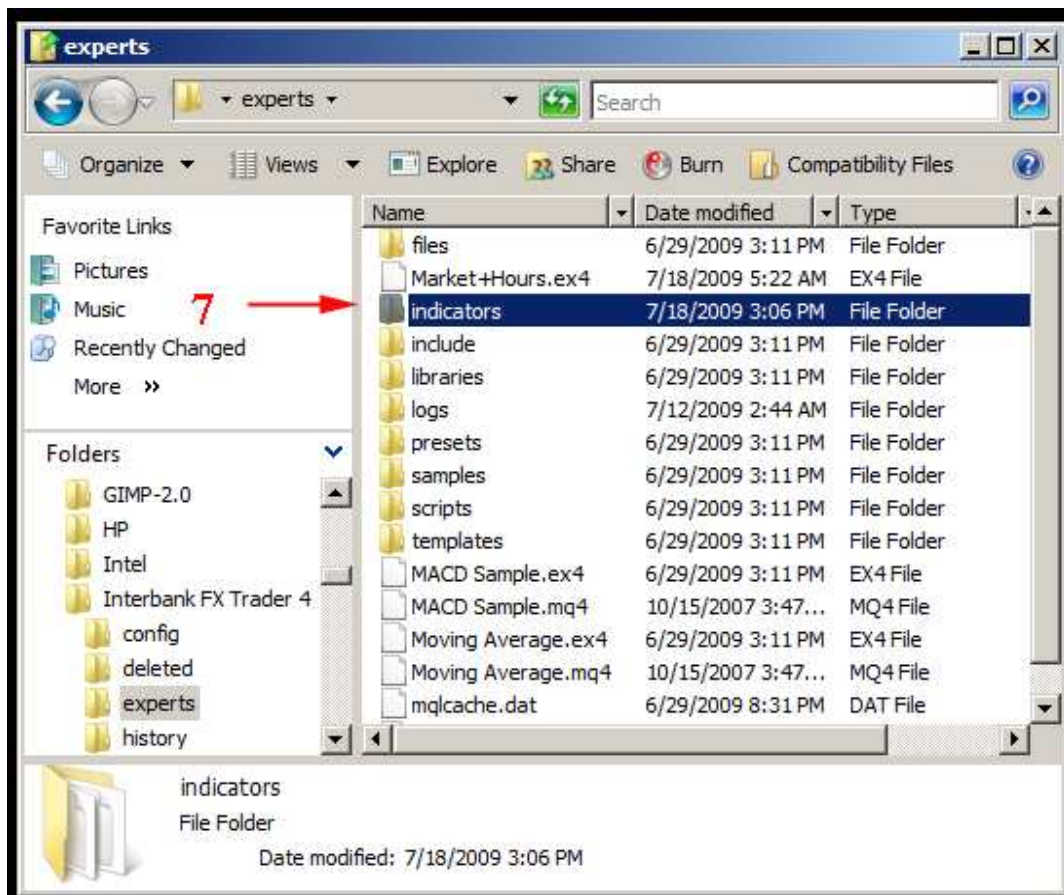
5: Scroll until you find your broker's folder and double click it.
(I use Interbank FX Trader 4)



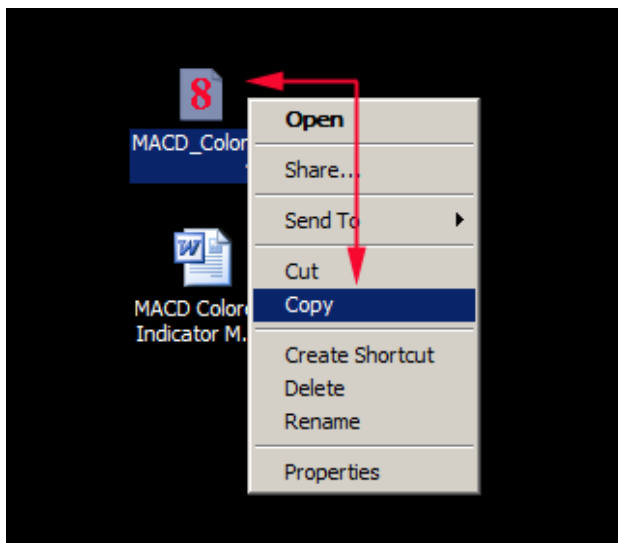
6: Scroll until you find experts folder and double click it:



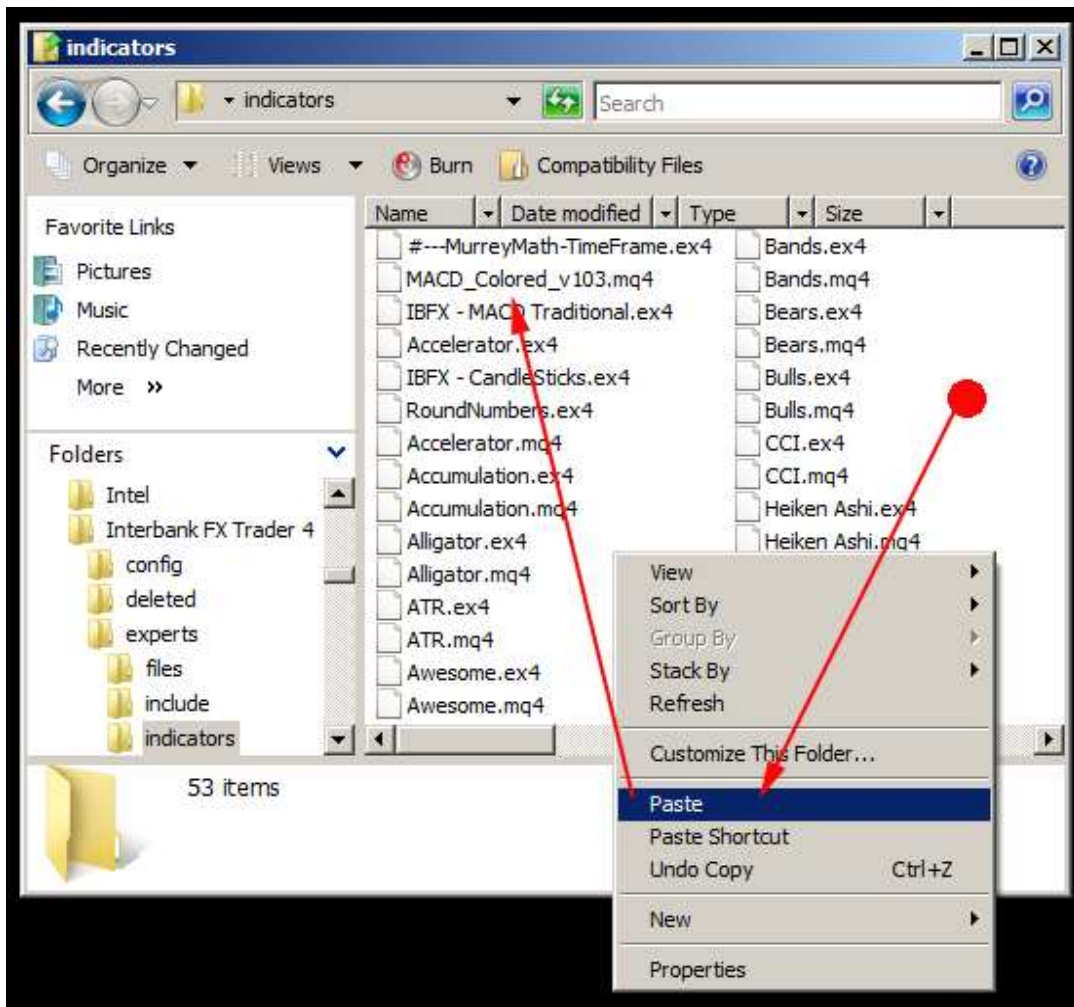
7: Scroll until you find indicators folder and double click it:
Leave this folder open for now:



8: Go back to your desk top, **right click** on MACD_Colored_v103 file and select copy:



9: Go back to your indicators folder (should already be open) **right click** anywhere in a clear space and select paste:
MACD_Colored_v103 should appear in your Indicators folder.



10: Now re-launch your MT4 platform and the MACD_Colored_v103 should appear in your Custom Indicators list.

Last: You now have a MACD_Colored_v103 file left on your desk top.
I created a folder named Original Indicators.
I keep all indicators I down load there just in case...Murphy shows up...

Note 1: The new version currently posted on pg 1 post #13 is v104.

Note 2: The document posted there is a Microsoft Office Word program.
You will need a program that will recognize Microsoft Word to be able to read it.

You can download a free program (OpenOffice.org) that will allow you to access Microsoft Word if needed.
