

Welcome to TSCalc.

To install the TSCalc:

Open the zip file, in the folder named TSCalc v1 - double click on the 'Setup' icon. Follow the instructions – The calculator will be installed.

How to use the Trader's Calculator:

1. Enter you Capital (funds).

Your capital value should be entered without the '£' sign and can have a number with up to 2 decimal places i.e. 1234.56


2. Enter the % risk - i.e. 3.

Risk % should be entered as a number i.e. 3, 3.5 or 5 etc.

3. With your mouse click on the calculator in the bottom left corner. This will give you your 'Risk Value per Trade'. It will produce a pop-up with check inputs – This is because there are no 'Entry' or 'Stop' entries – just click OK.



Example of Risk value per trade:



4. Enter your 'Entry' figure for your trade.

6. Enter your 'Stop' Figure for your trade.

To enter the figures for the Entry and Stop field, enter whole numbers. For example some brokers use '12345.60', others may use 1.23456. In both cases you can ignore the last digit and enter a whole number i.e. 12345 (The last digit is a tenth of 1 whole number. It is used to assist in adding accuracy to brokers quoted prices!).

You can of course enter the data as:

12345.6 = 12345.6 or 12345

1.23456 = 12345.6 or 12345

7. With your mouse click on the bottom left calculator. This will show your potential points loss figures and you're 'Points Value' for the trade (given the Capital Risk % you calculated at the beginning).

Example:



To clear risk management fields:

To clear the 'Capital' field click on the word 'Capital'.

To clear the '% Risk' field click on '% Risk'.

To clear the 'Capital, % Risk and Risk value per trade' click on the '£' sign.

To clear trade set-up fields:

To clear the 'Entry' field click on the word Entry.

To clear the 'Stop' field click on the word Stop.

To clear the ALL fields click on the dustbin.
