Nice trades and many thanks for your posts with usual great explanations. 👍 I am still busy with outside business commitments but hope to get back to trading soon and miss our trading community..... 😎

I noticed a few more scalping threads but most continue to rely on lagging/re-painting indicators in lieu of learning how to trade with the Market Makers and their momentum for quick profits. Many scalping threads have come and gone as new traders look for signals that just don't work in the long run.

There is no substitution for learning how the FX market really works to protect capital and most of those traders that follow signals will blow their accounts as happened so many times through the years. As we have discussed here many times, all that is needed to be successful is PA knowledge and follow the smart money trade our key levels.

There is no short cut or mystery to scalping as with any profitable profession, one must study and practice.

No pretty indicators needed just observing MM's momentum in relation to to key levels as support and resistance as keeping it simple and reduced my usual 5 lots to only 1 lot due to session and time of day.

(If I would have traded my usual 5 lots; $5 \times 12 \text{ pips} = 60 \text{ pips}$ in less then 1 minute not too bad for 1 quick FIFO scalp a nice little sting 🐝) Our system works as it has withstood the test of time....



IMO most traders make trading/scalping more difficult then it is by watching too many useless not needed indicators and never actually acquire a understanding why PA performs as it does..... 😞

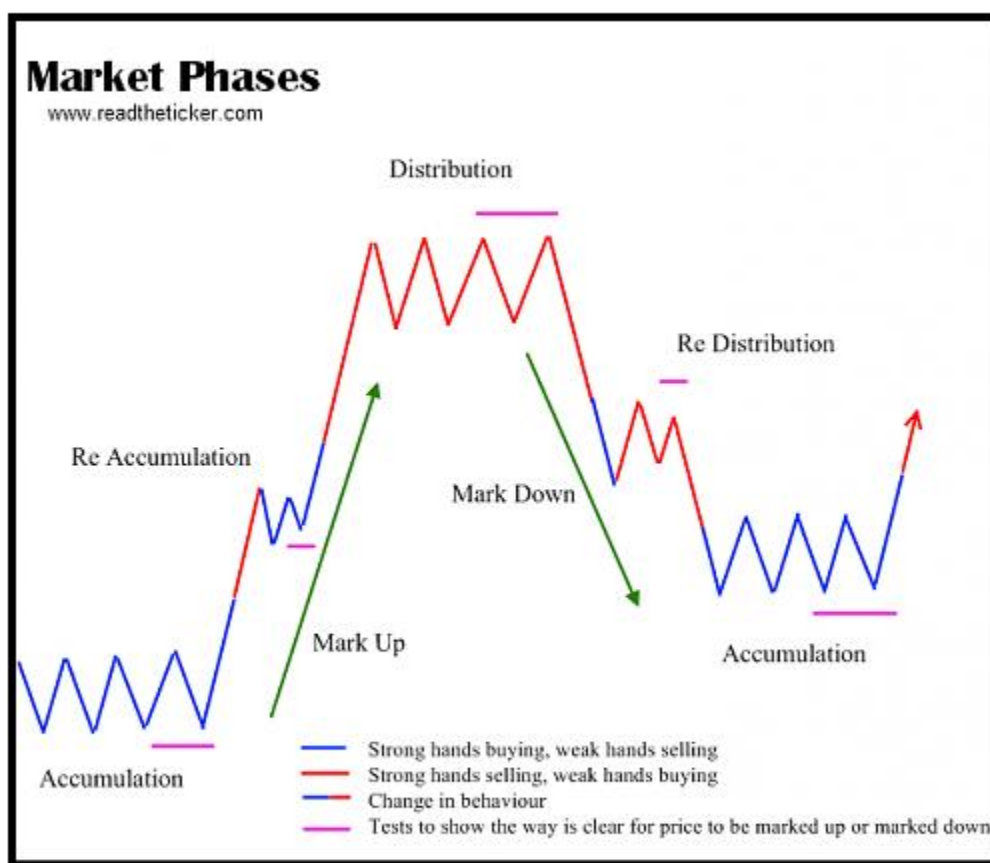

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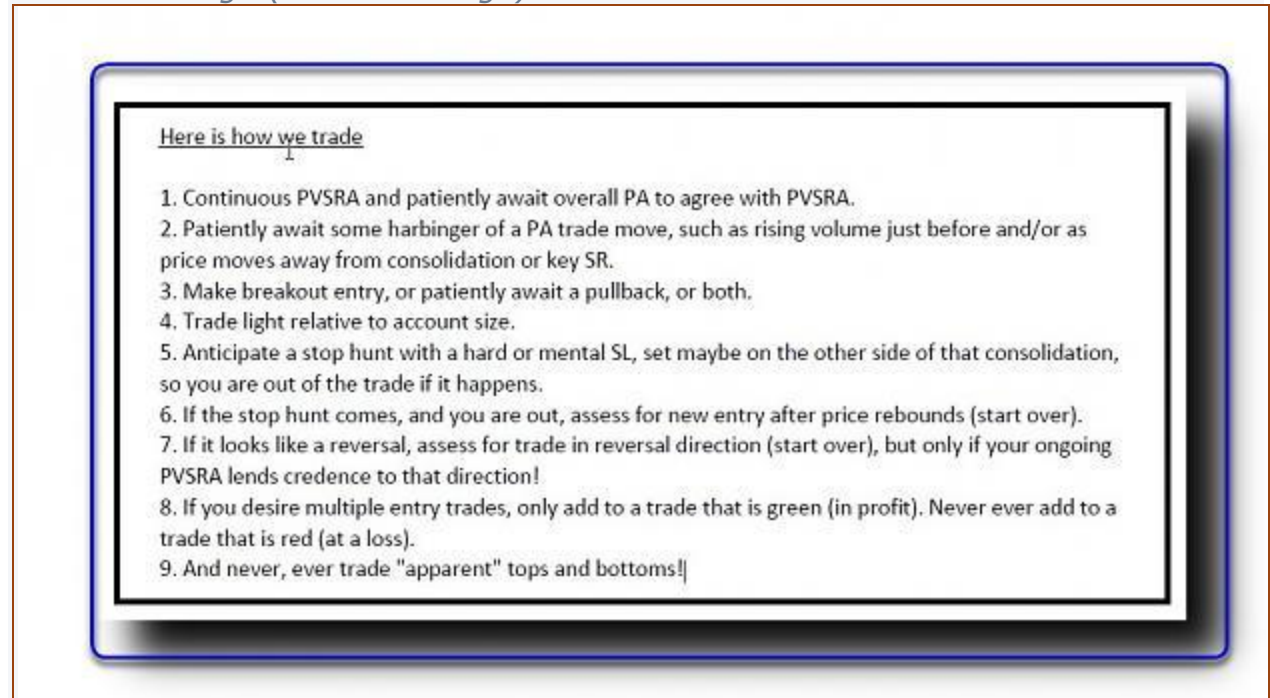

Also, as I have discussed many times, observing the often high momentum at the beginning of a NEW hour candle.

Pairing this new hour candle opening with the location of PA relative to our KEY LEVELS as S & R can very often signal a high momentum PVSRA confirmed entry...😎

The current session and time of day must also be considered....The key is momentum to quickly carry you to your FIFO target.....Momentum is extremely important when scalping so the trader won't get caught in a retrace or slow ranging and stop hunts.

I would like to hear some posted feed back from our Scalpers who decide to pay special attention to NEW HOUR PVSRA ENTRIES to hear if this observation has been helpful...



This observation has served me well through the years and I have discussed this topic many times but have not seen any trader follow through or comments.

(Pardon this slow posting...I'm away on my cell hating this small keyboard...😞)

That said, I have observed that 1) A lot of times, PA almost reaches my target on the last minute of the hourly candle, and then when the new hourly candle starts, PA goes immediately to the opposite direction. This has happened so many times that whenever I open my position very close to the time the hourly candle is about to end, I will close it before the new hourly candle starts. Usually on the very last...

Yes and that is a good reason NOT to open a trade close too the new hour candle and wait to see if a FIFO momentum entry presents its self with the NEW hr candle..😎

The magic words are S & Rand MOMENTUM....with a established trend...😏

I'm just offering a heads up as I make nice pips with this observation and have many times. Each trader must find what works for them I'm just sharing my experience...😎

Let's get real; All that is needed on any chart to trade successfully is.....KEY LEVELS (depicting S & R.).....200 EMA (trend).....and ability to observe and identify momentum with tick volume.

All other indicators are mostly lagging and provide somewhat of a false security blanket. I have and do trade often from such a Clean chart just for reinforcement not to lose trading skills and to detect my mistakes with a fairly bare bones chart.

This gives me the opportunity to find my personal mistakes with NO INDICATORS TO BLAME...😏

Hey Guys,

Don't over think our PVSRA scalping system. I took the original system which was primarily designed by TAH to be a position trading system from the M15 chart and made some PVSRA entry condition changes traded from the M1 chart. I morphed the original system into our current style because it works much better for quick FIFO scalps.

Even the original PVSRA system was changed from the old Sonic R system. There has been many changes through the years even up to the currently traded position system at another forum..

So let's not get side tracked and bring in confusion by referring back to the old system for PVSRA entry conditions. Our current system works so let us focus on the multitudes of posted trades in this thread for our learning experiences not the old.

The old PVSRA PDF'S are only to serve and give a basic understanding of our quest to understand how the market works so we can trade the Market Makers momentum by gleaming insight as to their intentions. NOT FOR FIFO HIGH MOMENTUM ENTRIES.

So let's stay focused and not discuss and confuse with discussion about the old which does not apply.

So bottom line PLEASE NO MORE DISCUSSION ABOUT A OLD SYSTEM AND FOCUS ON OUR SUCCESSFUL PVSRA SCALPING ONLY.

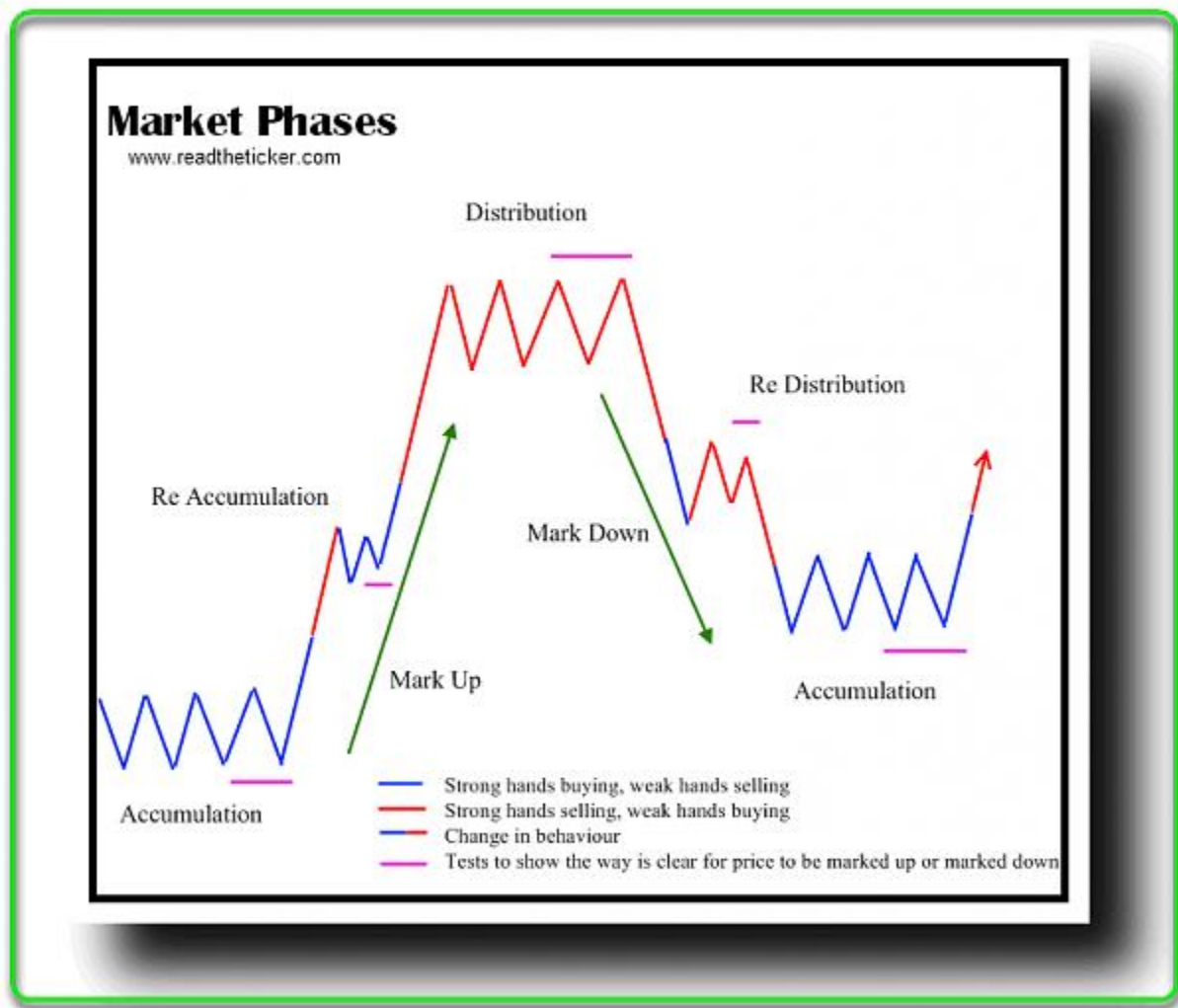

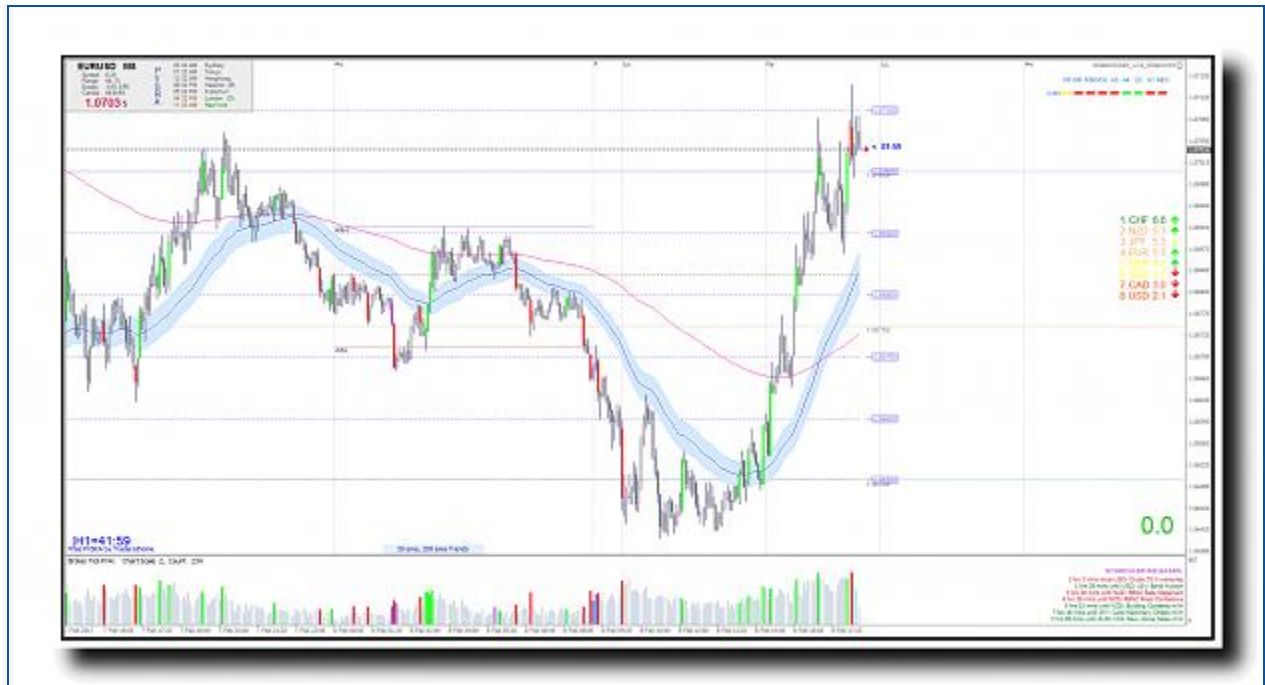

Your high momentum safe entry was at the open of the NEW HOUR CANDLE. I have suggested with many posts that this candle often offers the best entry opportunitynot always of course but often. I stalk and will wait for this candle to catch a FIFO scalp. Depending on the Session traded and time of day, I know traders that will ONLY stalk to trade this opening and make one trade per hour candle and then be careful of retraces and profit taking.

One of the issues that traders must learn to overcome is to NOT OVER TRADE. When we sit in front of our computers often for hours and because of the personality of most traders wanting too trade, we begin to see trades that are not there.

I have had to overcome this impulse and had to learn to control this very common issue. Trading requires discipline and this can be a struggle for many.

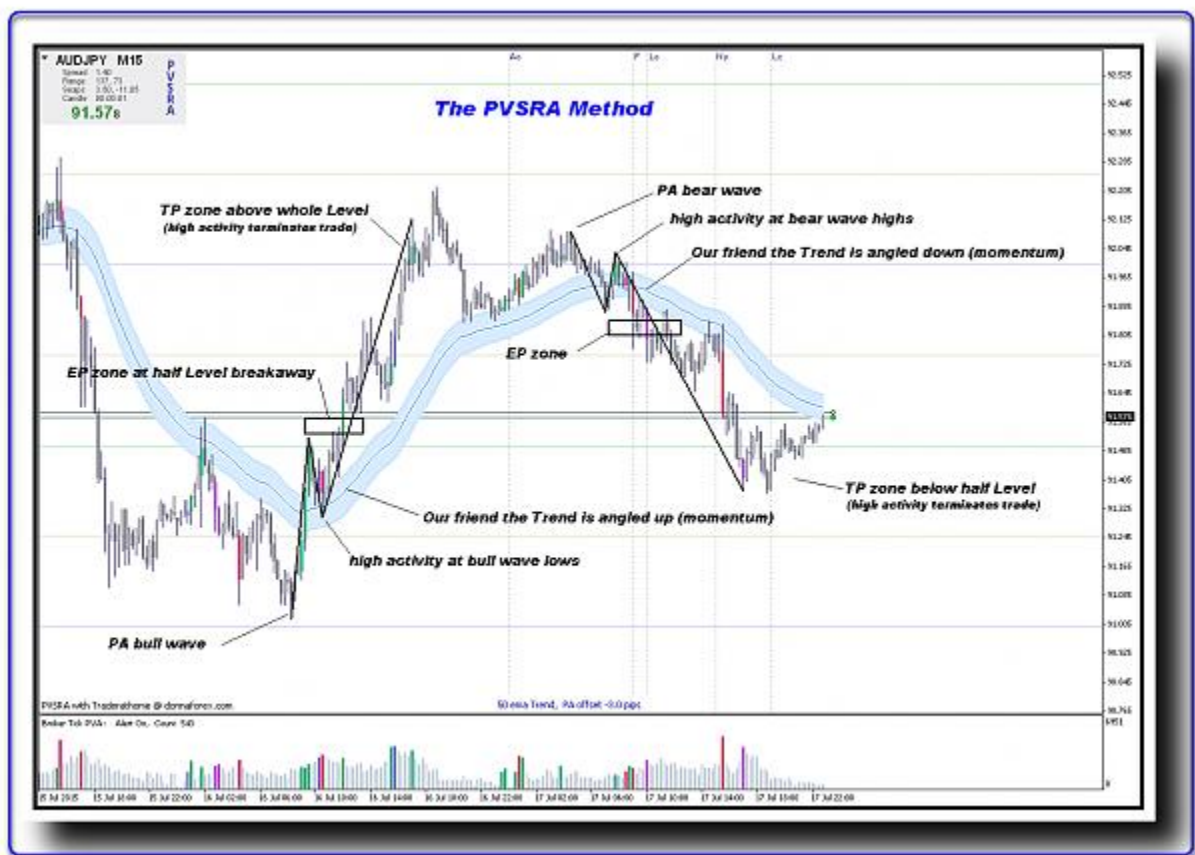

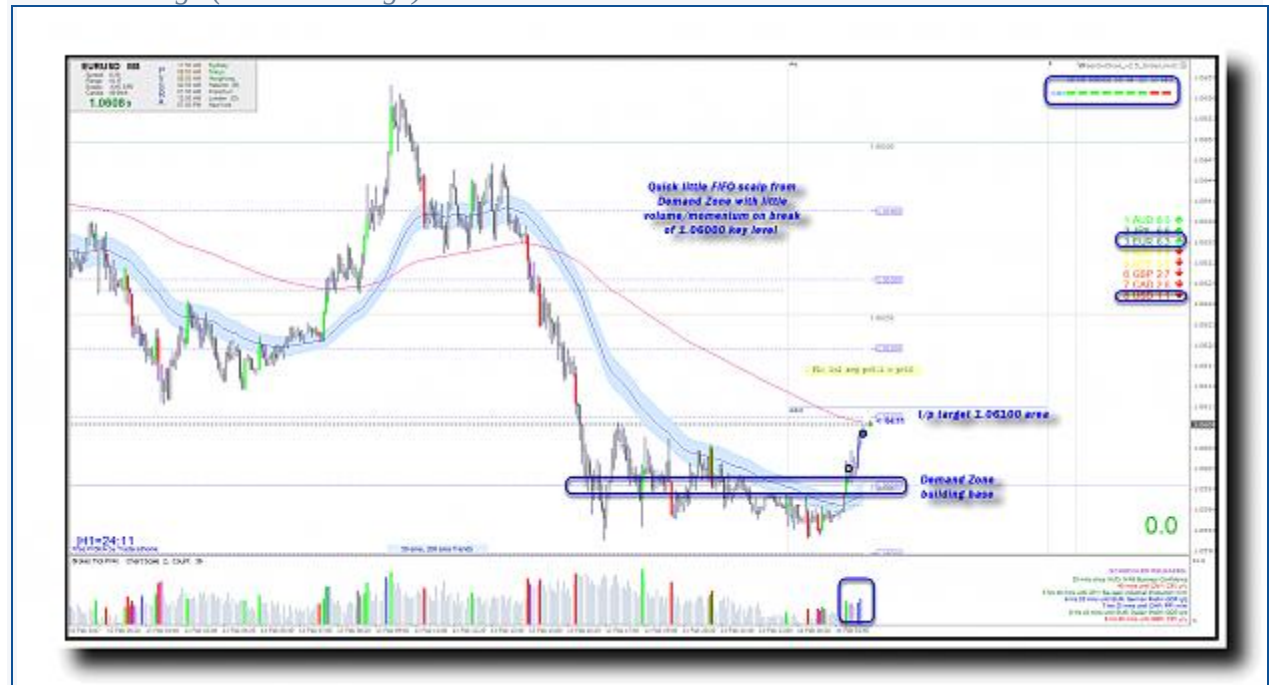

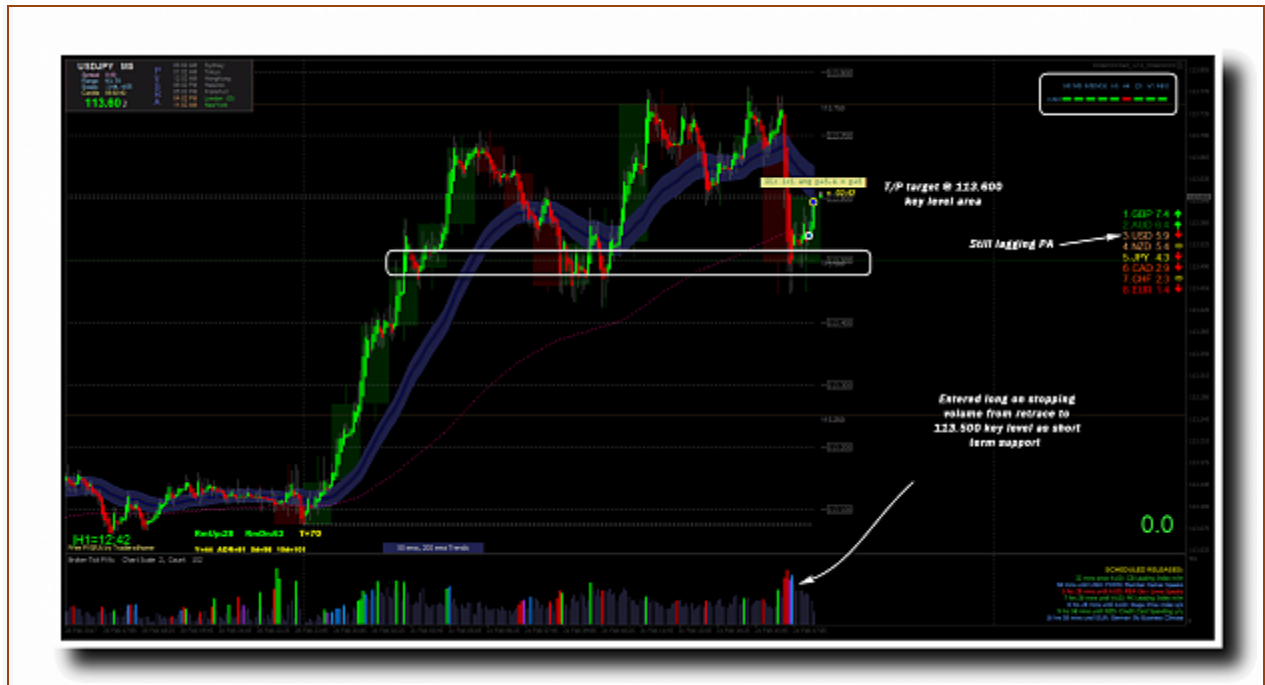

It's that simple, no market makers. If stunts are taking place, too many retail traders are in the flow, and they will hunt their stops to gain their contract. It's not MM, it's just near-term business for Central...

If you have a interest in our PVSRA scalping system, I suggest that you read the excellent PDF written by TAH the original founder of our system. Our system was originally styled to be traded on M15 and above with a drop down to M1 for PVSRA confirmed entry. I only morphed the original system to fit my FIFO scalping style. There is much more to our style that can

best be understood by reading our PDF's and observing the many posted charts with great explanations and I am not going to take more time or space here for further explanations as all has been outlined throughout this thread and can be found by reviewing our previous PVSRA thread.

This is a small excerpt taken from The Golden Posts Collection;

"Price - Some people say "Price Action is King". I say, we cannot know how the MMs (Market Makers) will move price next, period. But price tends to consolidate above key SR when MMs are filling short orders for SM (Smart Money) and long orders for DM (Dumb Money), and price tends to consolidate below key SR when MMs are filling long orders for SM and short orders for DM. The MMs are also "SM", and they tend to do the other SMs "one better"! This means that after the MMs fill the SM/DM orders, they might move price a bit further in an attempt to stop out some of those SM executed orders and sucker in more DM; both giving liquidity for the MMs to add to their own SM side position. Yes, the MMs are bastards. But the point is that could leave price not "nicely" above or below a SR anymore, yet more consolidation can occur."

We make every attempt to gleam any insight available by observing PA relative to key levels and 50 & 200 emas as S & R and closely watch for retraces to and near these levels for confirmed PVSRA entries.

I see in your Bio that you have no PVSRA trades posted from either thread. I always love it when someone stops by with no scalping experience and feels compelled to offer insight to current successful traders/scalpers when they in fact have zero posted credible experience and ***only 3 posts since 2009!...*** 🤔
