
May 2021 compared with April 2021

## Industrial producer prices up by 1.3% in the euro area and by 1.4% in the EU

Up by 9.6% in both the euro area and the EU compared with May 2020

In May 2021, industrial producer prices rose by 1.3% in the **euro area** and by 1.4% in the **EU**, compared with April 2021, according to estimates from **Eurostat, the statistical office of the European Union**. In April 2021, prices increased by 0.9% in both the **euro area** and the **EU**.

In May 2021, compared with May 2020, industrial producer prices increased by 9.6% in both the **euro area** and the **EU**.



### Monthly comparison by main industrial grouping and by Member State

Industrial producer prices in the **euro area** in May 2021, compared with April 2021, increased by 2.1% in the energy sector, by 1.8% for intermediate goods, by 0.4% for capital goods and by 0.3% for durable consumer goods and for non-durable consumer goods. Prices in total industry excluding energy increased by 0.9%.

In the **EU**, industrial producer prices increased by 2.3% in the energy sector, by 1.9% for intermediate goods, by 0.4% for capital goods and for durable consumer goods, and by 0.3% for non-durable consumer goods. Prices in total industry excluding energy increased by 1.0%.

The industrial producer prices increased in all Member States, with the highest increases being recorded in **Ireland** (+5.3%), **Denmark** (+3.3%) and **Finland** (+2.6%).

### Annual comparison by main industrial grouping and by Member State

Industrial producer prices in the **euro area** in May 2021, compared with May 2020, increased by 25.1% in the energy sector, by 9.2% for intermediate goods, by 2.0% for durable consumer goods, by 1.9% for non-durable consumer goods and by 1.8% for capital goods. Prices in total industry excluding energy increased by 4.9%.

In the **EU**, industrial producer prices increased by 24.8% in the energy sector, by 9.4% for intermediate goods, by 2.3% for durable consumer goods, by 2.0% for non-durable consumer goods and by 1.8% for capital goods. Prices in total industry excluding energy increased by 5.0%.

The industrial producer prices increased in all Member States, with the highest increases being registered in **Ireland** (+45.1%), **Belgium** (+20.1%) and **Denmark** (+17.2%).

### Geographical information

The **euro area** (EA19) includes Belgium, Germany, Estonia, Ireland, Greece, Spain, France, Italy, Cyprus, Latvia, Lithuania, Luxembourg, Malta, the Netherlands, Austria, Portugal, Slovenia, Slovakia and Finland.

The **European Union** (EU27) includes Belgium, Bulgaria, Czechia, Denmark, Germany, Estonia, Ireland, Greece, Spain, France, Croatia, Italy, Cyprus, Latvia, Lithuania, Luxembourg, Hungary, Malta, the Netherlands, Austria, Poland, Portugal, Romania, Slovenia, Slovakia, Finland and Sweden.

### Methods and definitions

The **index of producer prices** shows (in the national currency of the country concerned) changes in the ex-works sale prices of all products sold on the domestic market, excluding imports. Euro area and EU indices refer to overall weighted price changes. The figures are not calendar day or seasonally adjusted.

Total industry covers NACE rev.2 sections B to D + E36.

### Revisions and timetable

Compared with data issued in the News Release 64/2021 of 2 June 2021, the monthly percentage change for April 2021 has been revised from +1.0% to +0.9% in the euro area and remains unchanged at +0.9% in the EU. The annual percentage change remains unchanged at +7.6% in both the euro area and the EU.
