
September 2023 compared with August 2023

## Volume of retail trade down by 0.3% in the euro area and by 0.2% in the EU

Down by 2.9% in the euro area and by 2.7% in the EU compared with September 2022

In September 2023, the seasonally adjusted volume of retail trade decreased by 0.3% in the **euro area** and by 0.2% in the **EU**, compared with August 2023, according to estimates from **Eurostat, the statistical office of the European Union**. In August 2023, the retail trade volume decreased by 0.7% in the **euro area** and by 0.5% in the **EU**.

In September 2023 compared with September 2022, the calendar adjusted retail sales index decreased by 2.9% in the **euro area** and by 2.7% in the **EU**.



## Monthly comparison by retail sector and by Member State

In the **euro area** in September 2023, compared with August 2023, the volume of retail trade decreased by 1.9% for non-food products and by 0.9% for automotive fuels, while it increased by 1.4% for food, drinks and tobacco.

In the **EU**, the volume of retail trade decreased by 1.8% for non-food products, while it increased by 0.1% for automotive fuels and by 1.3% for food, drinks and tobacco.

Among Member States for which data are available, the largest monthly decreases in the total retail trade volume were registered in **Slovakia** (-2.0%), **Sweden** (-1.1%), **Germany** and the **Netherlands** (both -0.8%). The highest increases were observed in **Slovenia** (+1.1%), **Poland** (+1.0%) and **Denmark** (+0.9%).

## Annual comparison by retail sector and by Member State

In the **euro area** in September 2023, compared with September 2022, the volume of retail trade decreased by 7.5% for automotive fuels, by 3.4% for non-food products and by 1.0% for food, drinks and tobacco.

In the **EU**, the retail trade volume decreased by 6.9% for automotive fuels, by 3.2% for non-food products and by 0.9% for food, drinks and tobacco.

Among Member States for which data are available, the largest yearly decreases in the total retail trade volume were registered in **Slovenia** (-17.0%), **Belgium** (-8.4%) and **Hungary** (-7.3%). The highest increases were observed in **Spain** (+7.5%), **Cyprus** (+4.1%) and **Luxembourg** (+2.6%).

## Geographical information

The **euro area** (EA20) includes Belgium, Germany, Estonia, Ireland, Greece, Spain, France, Croatia, Italy, Cyprus, Latvia, Lithuania, Luxembourg, Malta, the Netherlands, Austria, Portugal, Slovenia, Slovakia and Finland.

The **European Union** (EU27) includes Belgium, Bulgaria, Czechia, Denmark, Germany, Estonia, Ireland, Greece, Spain, France, Croatia, Italy, Cyprus, Latvia, Lithuania, Luxembourg, Hungary, Malta, the Netherlands, Austria, Poland, Portugal, Romania, Slovenia, Slovakia, Finland and Sweden.

## Methods and definitions

The **index of the volume of retail trade** measures the evolution of the turnover in retail trade, adjusted for price changes (deflated), i.e. the evolution of the total amount of goods sold, based on data adjusted for calendar and seasonal effects.

**Seasonally adjusted** euro area and EU series are calculated by aggregating the seasonally adjusted national data.

Missing observations from Member States for recent months are estimated for the calculation of the euro area and the EU aggregates.

## Revisions and timetable

Data of previous months have been revised compared to those issued in the News Release [111/2023](#) of 4 October 2023. The monthly percentage change for August 2023 has been revised from -1.2% to -0.7% in the euro area and from -0.9% to -0.5% in the EU. The annual percentage change has been revised from -2.1% to -1.8% in the euro area and from -2.0% to -1.8% in the EU.
